The Fundraiser subcommittee met last night to discuss the options to revise the local wellness policy in regards to the fundraising policy. The consensus was that we amend the current wellness policy to state the following:

“The district will allow up to 2 exemption days per school specifically to be allocated for field days. Exemption days must be submitted to the FSMC prior to the event taking place.”

We also wanted to stress that the principals understand that an exemption day does NOT allow them to serve snacks at the same time as meal service times. All food being sold during the field days must be sold outside of the meal service times.
