Elementary Student Representative provided feedback:

- Nutrition staff at KJ is friendly and nice to the students
- Would like to see breakfast service extended
- Nutrition staff performs duties in a professional manner “they do not throw food on your plate”

SHAC Adviser provided feedback on the app for the menu and encouraged materials for parents and students

Counselor Representative asked about portion sizes, Food Service Director and Co-Chair responded about the reasons for portion control based on nutritional standards.

Sara Bintrim provided the following points for the committee:

- Aramark will review meal service times and work with principals to expand access to breakfast.
- The district is Community Eligibility Provision approved for 5 years. Students do not pay for breakfast, lunch, or dinner.
- Each day the menu will feature hot and cold fruit or vegetable offering.
- Noted, juice is also offered at lunch.
- Limited Time Offerings are happening this week to see how the students respond. They will continue the menu based on students’ responses.
- Aramark is using surveys to determine what adjustments to make. For second semester, parents will see more bone-in chicken, deli offerings, tater tots, pastas, enchiladas, and quesadillas.
- They offer special promotions like free cookies on National Cookie Day

Co-chair announced we will conduct a special subcommittee meeting for students to provide more feedback about child nutrition. The sessions will be held January 9th at the high school and January 10th at McCowan Middle School.
